RESOLUTION NO. 2011-64

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A LONG TERM ENCROACHMENT PERMIT FOR NUSHAGAK COOPERATIVE TO INSTALL AN ALTERNATE 3 PHASE POWER LINE WITHIN AND ACROSS KANAKANAK ROAD TO SERVE PETER PAN SEAFOODS

WHEREAS, the Dillingham Municipal Code 12.08.020 (C) requires the Dillingham Planning Commission to make recommendations to the city council regarding long term encroachments into city rights-of-way and city property; and

WHEREAS, Nushagak Cooperative wishes to install an alternate primary feed across Kanakanak Road near the PAF boatyard for Peter Pan Seafoods; and

WHEREAS, DMC 12.08.020 C) requires the Dillingham Planning Commission to review the proposed long term encroachment application for compliance with DMC chapter 12.08 encroachment permits; and

WHEREAS, this primary feed will not interfere with any other public utility existing in the road; and

WHEREAS, the alternate power line will allow Nushagak Cooperative the ability to better accommodate power needs of the Peter Pan Seafoods Company; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham Planning Commission has considered the plans for installing the power lines and recommends the City Council approve this permit; and


WHEREAS, the City Council is required by DMC 12.08.020 (C) to act upon encroachment permit applications upon receipt and consideration of the recommendation of the Planning Commission;


