**A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG)**

WHEREAS, through resolution 2014-37 the Dillingham City Council approved the application for a Edward Byrne Memorial JAG grant; and

WHEREAS, the grant was submitted to fund a new full-time police officer position with a requested amount of \$114,063; and


WHEREAS, the City was notified on August 22, 2014 that we were approved for a \$50,000 grant once we submitted a revised budget; and

WHEREAS, the City will use these funds to assign an officer to work with the State in their Western Alaska Alcohol and Narcotic Team (WAANT) on a part-time basis; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham has formally applied for the grant and thereby agrees to the terms and conditions of the grant, and to adhere to any governing state regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Dillingham City Council that the grantee formally accepts the State of Alaska Department of Public Safety Edward Byrne Memorial JAG grant in the amount of \$50,000 and accepts the conditions of the grant agreement.
