A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL THANKING GOLDEN HEART PET ASSISTANCE LEAGUE, COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERS, AND PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT FOR THEIR PARTICIPATION IN THE ANIMAL SPAY AND NEUTERING CLINIC HELD APRIL 21-25, 2011

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham named spay and neutering clinics as one of its priorities in helping to promote a responsible and quality animal control program in Dillingham; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Department's Animal Control Services worked once again to bring out the Golden Heart Pet Assistance League (Golden Heart PAL), a non-profit organization based in North Pole, to hold another low cost spay/neuter clinic in Dillingham because it was determined there was a real need for it after their visit last fall; and

WHEREAS, over 80 animals, dogs and cats, were registered for the clinic held in Dillingham April 21-25, 2011; and



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City continue to assist in holding spay and neutering clinics in Dillingham in keeping with its desire to have a quality animal control program.


