A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL COMMENDING SAFE AND FEAR-FREE ENVIRONMENT FOR MAKING DILLINGHAM A BETTER PLACE WITH ITS COMMUNITY MURAL PROJECT

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Dillingham City Council thanks SAFE for making Dillingham a better place with its community mural project.


