RESOLUTION NO. 2011-47

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A LONG TERM ENCROACHMENT PERMIT FOR UTILITY INSTALLATION ACROSS EMPEROR WAY ROADWAY TO INSTALL CABLE, TELEVISION AND ELECTRICAL LINES TO LOT 4 BLOCK 9 NERKA VII SUBDIVISION

WHEREAS, a Dillingham resident wishes to have cable, electric and telephone lines installed to his property at Lot 4 Block 9 Nerka VII Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the proposed utility lines have to be installed across the Emperor Way North, a public right of way; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting May 16, 2011, the Dillingham Planning Commission reviewed the proposed long term encroachment application for compliance with chapter 12.08 encroachment permits; and

WHEREAS, the planning commission passed resolution 2011-07, May 17, 2011, recommending the city council approve this long term permit per DMC 12.08.020 (C) and DMC 12.08.070;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dillingham City Council approves a long term encroachment permit allowing Nushagak Cooperatives to install utilities across Emperor Way North, a public right of way, under the following conditions:


- that the City of Dillingham Administration, Public Works Department and Public Safety Department be notified 48 hours in advance of any work on public lands or in the public rights of way;
- that a new encroachment permit must be obtained before the utilities are moved from this location;
- that Nushagak Cooperatives restore the public land or public right-of-way to its former condition or better after completing the utility installations; and
- that Nushagak Cooperatives provide 2 copies of the as-builts of the installations to the City Planning Department within one month of installing them.

PASSED and ADOPTED by the Dillingham City Council on June 2, 2011.
