RESOLUTION NO. 2011-53

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR A STATE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT HARBOR IMPROVEMENT GRANT TO PURCHASE NEW FLOATS FOR THE HARBOR

WHEREAS, the floats that provide safe moorage for commercial and recreational boats in the Dillingham harbor are approximately twenty-seven (27) years old; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham ("City") has patched them many times including at least once in the last five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, there are two (2) floats that have to be pumped several times a week; and

WHEREAS, the cost to the City of regularly patching, reskinning, and pumping the floats equals or exceeds the cost of new floats; and


WHEREAS, the State's Transportation Department is soliciting proposals for harbor improvements until August 1, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Dillingham City Council that:


1. The City agrees to apply for an ADOT Harbor Improvements grant in the amount of \$100,000.
2. The City agrees to provide the required match of \$50,000.
3. The City Council authorizes the City Manager, or alternatively the Mayor, to sign all documents on behalf of the City.
