RESOLUTION NO. 2011-55

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR THE TOWER ROAD PAVING PROJECT TO QUALITY ASPHALT PRODUCTS (QAP)

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham (City) and the Curyung Tribal Council identified the need to improve Tower Road; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham has received a grant from the Denali Commission in the total amount of \$925,000 for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Curyung Tribal Council (Curyung) received grants from the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the Project which will pay all project costs in excess of the City's grant amount received from the Denali Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City and Curyung have agree to partner for this project and each entity understands the City will provide grant funding received from the Denali Commisison for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited competitive bids for Tower Road Project Phase II in the Bristol Bay Times and the Anchorage Daily News pursuant to Alaska Statute; and

WHEREAS, the Tower Road – Phase II consists of the final surfacing and paving of .85 miles; and

WHEREAS, the City received and opened three bids on June 6, 2011 which Bristol Environmental & Engineering Services Corporation (BEESC) as the Project Construction Management Services consultant reviewed; and

WHEREAS, BEESC considers the Low Bidder, Quality Asphalt Products, (QAP) to be a qualified contractor and recommends award of the contract to QAP; and

WHEREAS, QAP is licensed to perform construction in Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the low bid amount is within the proposed project budget;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The Dillingham City Council awards the contract for the Tower Road – Phase II to QAP of Anchorage, Alaska, for the base bid of \$467,000 plus the two additive alternates totaling \$186,000 for a total of \$653,000.
2. The Dillingham City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreement with QAP and to issue appropriate notices associated with the contract.
