A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A LONG TERM ENCROACHMENT PERMIT FOR NUSHAGAK COOPERATIVE TO INSTALL SIX POLES WITH STREET LIGHTING AND AN ANCHOR POLE ALONG THE NEWLY RENAMED LIL' LARRY ROAD

WHEREAS, the Dillingham Municipal Code 12.08.020 (C) requires the Dillingham Planning Commission to make recommendations to the city council regarding long term encroachments into city rights-of-way and city property; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Tower Road Project, the City requests Nushagak Cooperative install six poles for street lighting and an anchor pole along the newly renamed Lil' Larry Road; and

WHEREAS, DMC 12.08.020 C) requires the Dillingham Planning Commission to review the proposed long term encroachment application for compliance with DMC chapter 12.08 encroachment permits; and


WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham Planning Commission has considered the plans for these installations and recommends the City Council approve this permit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is required by DMC 12.08.020 (C) to act upon encroachment permit applications upon receipt and consideration of the recommendation of the Planning Commission;



Summary Statement.

Approved by the Planning Commission at their September 20, 2011 meeting.

The encroachment permit is necessary to comply with Dillingham Municipal code:

“12.08.010 Definitions. “Encroachments” shall be considered as any object above ground or below belonging to a private owner other than the municipality which has been or caused to be constructed or located within streets, public rights-of-way or other property dedicated to a public use. (Ord. 93-13 § 1 (part), 1993.)

12.08.020 (C) Approval of Long Term Permit. The city manager shall refer any encroachment permit application for a period exceeding one year to the city planning commission. The manager shall submit his recommendations regarding the application to the planning commission. The planning commission shall review the application, and forward a recommendation to the city council. The city council shall act upon the encroachment permit application only upon receipt and consideration of the recommendation of the planning commission. (Ord. 93-13 § 1 (part), 1993.)
