## IF you test positive for COVID-19: Take Steps to Protect Others Regardless of your Vaccination Status

- CONTACT your Healthcare Provider, especially if you're an older adult or have underlying medical conditions.
- STAY HOME, Isolate for at least 10 days. Stay in a specific room and away from other people in your house.
- GET REST and STAY HYDRATED. If you develop symptoms continue to isolate for at least 10 days after symptoms began and until you do not have a fever without using medications to reduce fever.

**If you travel, social distance and get tested 3-5 days after your return**

~ COVID Testing: 10 am to 6 pm

~ COVID Vaccinations: 10:30 am to 5:30 pm\*

\* COVID Vaccinations 2 weeks on, 2 weeks off. Available now until December 17<sup>th</sup>, and back January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022. Pfizer Vaccine available, no Moderna Vaccine.
