## **STATUS OF PATIENT SERVICES**

DILLINGHAM, ALASKA – The Bristol Bay Area Health Corporation has returned to normal operations in our inpatient care section after regular staffing levels of hospitalists have been reached. Patients may again be admitted to the Kanakanak Hospital for acute medical treatment and other health care services. BBAHC's Emergency Department and Outpatient Clinic continue to operate normally.

Walk-in clinics were eliminated in the summer of 2021 and replaced by same day access clinics, allowing patients the ability to schedule same day appointments. Patients can contact us at (907) 842-9369 to make an appointment with a provider. Please call ahead if you have COVID-19 symptoms and are seeking care. COVID-19 testing is available at the BBAHC COVID Annex, Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. We encourage patients to seek medical care when needed at BBAHC and are committed to providing quality patient-centered care for those in all 28 communities we serve.
