IF you test positive for COVID-19: Take Steps to Protect Others Regardless of your Vaccination Status

- CONTACT your Healthcare Provider, especially if you're an older adult or have underlying medical conditions.
- STAY HOME, Isolate for at least 5 days. If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can leave your house. Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
- GET REST and STAY HYDRATED. If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.

If you travel, social distance and get tested 3-5 days after your return
