A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING THE RESIGNATION OF BILL RODAWALT AND OFFER THANKS AND COMMENDATION FOR HIS SERVICE ON THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the responsibilities of a Council member requires the dedication of a great deal of personal time with no remuneration and Bill has given generously throughout his tenure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that it is with sincere thanks that the Mayor, City Council, and City staff offers their gratitude and a commendation for Bill Rodawalt's selfless time, participation, and leadership while serving on the Dillingham City Council.
