Summary Statement:

The Department of Public Safety has been working with Acting Chief of Police Craig Maines since Chief Dan Pasquello retired in May of 2022.

Recruitment for the chief of police position is ongoing. Several application have been received. However, the process for hiring a key position takes a considerable amount of time, and will include public and council engagement.

To enhance direction and support in the Department of Public Safety the City Manager has offered Tracy O'Malley an appointment to the position of Interim Chief of Police effective July 1, 2023, contingent upon concurrence of the the City Council (DMC 2.44.010).

Ms. O'Malley has 17 years of experience in law enforcement including four and a half years with the City of Dillingham. Additionally, she has experience in a supervisory capacity, as well as time served as the Law Enforcement Academy Director in Fairbanks. This appointment also allows Officer Maines to return to his role as Sergeant which will increase support to DPD.
