#### Q: What else can I do?

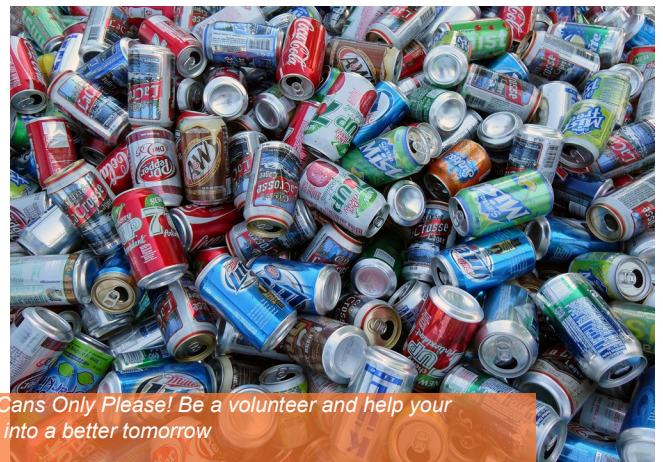

We are seeking consistent rotations of 2 to 3 volunteers per shift every 2 to 3 weeks. Consistency to your commitment is important and will really help the effort.

### Responsible Aluminum Can Collection

If you cannot volunteer time, your aluminum cans are still needed. However, **Aluminum cans only please, no steel or trash.** You can bring them in a box and just dump them into the bin. This will help eliminate unnecessary plastic bag waste.
