Subject: City Closures

To prevent or slow the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), the Dillingham City Council has instructed the following City facility closures:

- Library (book drop will remain open)**
- Senior Center**
- City Hall (drop box by front door available for payments)**
- DMV**

City Council has authorized a work from home policy. All city workers who are able to work from home have been directed to do so. This is the recommendation of public health experts across the state, country, and world.

All city email will be operational. Department phones will be forwarded to remote locations so the community will still be able to contact City Staff;
