ALL RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED

- ☐ The boat harbor is NOT open for business as usual. Extended stays will **NOT** be allowed
- ☐ Use floats for emergencies and repairs ONLY.
- ☐ Do **NOT** tie up to floats, docks or bulkheads this season without permission from the Harbor Master.
- ☐ You may use the floats, docks, and bulkheads for short periods and only with permission. The Harbor Master will decide permission and duration based on need.
- ☐ If your needs will require more than a couple of hours to complete, you must arrange for your boat to be hauled out of the water and moved to a boat yard or placed in a temporary site for repairs. The Harbor Master will determine if this is necessary.
- ☐ An RSW maintenance spot will be designated at the bottom of the south ramp. You **MUST** schedule through the RSW technician, and be approved by the Harbor Master.
- ☐ Harbor facilities and services will be available on a scheduled basis, including ice purchase, bathhouse, crane and other services. Contact the Harbor Master for information.
- ☐ While you are in the harbor, you must comply with all State of Alaska Health Mandates and City of Dillingham COVID-19 Emergency regulations including quarantine, social distancing and wearing face masks in public areas.
