RESOLUTION 2017-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO WAIVE THE PURCHASING RESTRICTIONS TO ADVERTISE FOR A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL TO INSTALL A NEW COILING DOOR AT THE DOWNTOWN FIRE HALL

WHEREAS, the Dillingham Volunteer Fire Department is in the process of purchasing a new ambulance that will arrive in late June or early July 2017; and

WHEREAS given the current dimensions of the Downtown Fire Hall, the new ambulance will not fit inside the garage doors that are currently installed; and

WHEREAS, the City has purchased a coiling door that will accommodate the new ambulance to be parked inside the Downtown Fire Hall; and


WHEREAS; the City went out to bid for installation of the coiling door in 2016, but only received one bid as it was the end of the construction season; and

WHEREAS, the City is looking to again advertise for a RFP to have the coiling door installed prior to arrival of the new ambulance; and

WHEREAS, Dillingham Municipal Code (DMC) 4.30.130, Exemptions, Section B., allows exemptions to the purchasing restrictions if the City Council determines that the public interest would be best served by waiving the procedures, and that such determination must be made in the form of a resolution adopted prior to the proposed action;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Dillingham City Council authorizes the City Manager to advertise for the RFP with a reduced advertisement period (from 30 days to 21 days) in order to award the contract at the May Council meeting.
