**A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR DESIGN OF THE DILLINGHAM SEWER LAGOON AERATION PROJECT**

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WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham received a Notice of Violation for the Dillingham Lagoon on June 26, 2017; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to address the NOV, the City Council adopted Resolution 2017-25 and subsequent Action Memorandum 2017-12 which allowed staff to receive bids and award a contract for the Lagoon and Dock Lift Station Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, in order to continue addressing the Notice of Violation it is imperative that the City design and construct an aeration system at the lagoon; and

WHEREAS, if this project is designed it will be considered shovel ready, and, therefore, eligible for any State and/or Federal money that becomes available; and

WHEREAS, the City will begin advertising the RFP once funds are available for the design and expect to award a contract at a future Council meeting;


