**A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL APPROVING ENGINEERING DESIGN FUNDS FOR CIP PROJECTS**

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WHEREAS, the Dillingham City Council has approved the FY19 CIP list and authorized the City Manager to identify funding for projects; and

WHEREAS, engineering designs are now required to move forward on a number of capital improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the city has identified funds available for engineering design for the Landfill Wells, Water System Improvements, Road Rehabilitation, and support for RFP's; and

WHEREAS, the city has been working for several years on current CIP projects for the landfill, and water projects and timing is important to meet grant funding requirements;

WHEREAS, as streets continue to deteriorate, it is important to quality of life to address road failures;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Dillingham City Council, authorizes the City Manager to do a budget revision to the FY19 budget and use \$230,000 from Landfill Contractual/Profession line item, and \$10,500 from the FY19 budget surplus for engineering support on FY19 CIP projects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that:

The following capital improvement projects will utilize the identified funding for engineering design and support as follows:

Landfill Groundwater Monitoring Wells	\$	30,000
Water System Improvements – Downtown Streets Support	\$	67,500
D Street & Seward Street Rehabilitation Project	\$	124,000
Engineering Support for RFP's on FY19 CIP Projects	\$	19,000
