RESOLUTION NO. 2018-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A GRANT APPLICATION AND MATCHING FUNDS FOR A NEW FIRE ENGINE

WHEREAS, the Dillingham Volunteer Fire Department, DVFD, has a need for a fire truck to replace the 1971 F-660, Engine 2, which is outdated and no longer capable to fulfill the requirements of the department needs; and

WHEREAS, the age of the F-660 and the operational procedures and knowledge needed to operate the truck limit the number of people that can operate it; and

WHEREAS, the truck has limited storage and cannot accommodate all the equipment the department needs for response to various types of call; and

WHEREAS, the DVFD has discovered a Department of Homeland Security Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) that will cover 95% of the cost; and

WHEREAS, the granting agency require recipients to come up with a 5% hard match for AFG grants, which will be no more than \$18,250; and


WHEREAS, the grant deadline is October 26, 2018, with the grant being awarded June 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, if awarded the grant the DVFD will work with the Planning Department to place Request for Bids; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dillingham City Council approves the AFG grant application and authorizes the expenditure for a new fire truck from the ambulance fund not to exceed \$18,250.

Summary Statement:

The DVFD needs to replace old and failing equipment. The 1971 Ford F-660 is outdated, does not have adequate storage for needed items, and the design has safety concerns regarding the safe entrance and exit of the vehicle.

The Department of Homeland Security has grant opportunities available that cover 95% of the cost of a new fire truck. A new fire engine will allow the needed storage space for all equipment and have a water pump that will keep up with the demands for extinguishing a large fire.

Keeping the fire department equipment updated is essential to having an effective DVFD.
