RESOLUTION NO. 2019-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL CALLING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION ON MARCH 26, 2019 FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY A PROPOSITION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS TO FINANCE THE CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS, AND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADDITION TO THE LAKE ROAD FIRE HALL

WHEREAS, under the provisions of AS 29.47.190, the City of Dillingham ("City") may incur general obligation debt only after a bond authorization ordinance is approved by a majority of those voting on the question at a regular or special election; and

WHEREAS, the 2018-2023 Capital Improvement List includes projects that are critical for City infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Dillingham City Council has directed the City evaluate the condition of the roads and develop a plan for road improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Council intends that the City issue general obligation bonds that the voters approve only in accordance with road improvements and fire hall renovations that are on the current CIP; and

WHEREAS, Dillingham Municipal Code 3.10.040 requires the election shall be conducted on the ninth Tuesday following certification of a valid initiative, referendum or recall petition, or, in other cases, following adoption of a resolution by the city council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Dillingham City Council that:


1. A special election in and for the City is called for Tuesday, March 26, 2019. The City Clerk is authorized and directed to prepare for and conduct the special election in accordance with Dillingham Municipal Code.
2. At the special election there shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the City a proposition for the issuance of general obligation bonds of the City for road construction, and/or the Lake Road Fire Hall renovation.
3. This resolution shall take effect upon passage and approval.
