RESOLUTION NO. 2011-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO WAIVE THE ADVERTISING REQUIREMENTS TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES TO PROVIDE CONSULTING SUPPORT THROUGH THE NEXT STEPS OF THE ANNEXATION PROCESS

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham is in need of consulting services to assist the City with consulting support through the next steps of the annexation process; and

WHEREAS, Dillingham Municipal Code (DMC) 4.30.130 allows waiving of purchase restrictions if the City Council determines that the public interest would best be served by waiving the procurement procedures in the form of a resolution adopted prior to the proposed action; and

WHEREAS, the waiver is based on the criteria outlined in DMC 4.30.130, Exemptions B.4, the services are of a professional nature requiring specialized knowledge and judgment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the City Manager to waive the advertising requirements and proceed to negotiate with George Cannelos & Associates LLC to assist the City in the next steps of the annexation process by preparing and providing expert testimony during the LBC Public Hearing, and offering other advice as requested to support Dillingham's annexation effort.
