WHEREAS, Deanna Hardin of Happy Tails offered her professional services on a contract basis to assist the City with housing as well as to find good homes for those homeless pets deemed adoptable; and

WHEREAS, the City contracted services with Deanna Hardin for the last twelve (12) months from March 2010 until February 2011;


