RESOLUTION NO. 2011-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE 2010 UPDATE OF THE DILLINGHAM COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Dillingham Municipal code 2.68.160 (A) requires that the Planning Commission prepare and recommend to the City Council a Comprehensive Plan consisting of maps and related texts for the systematic development of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham entered into a contract with Agnew::Beck and Associates, on the 8th of September, 2009, to update the Dillingham Comprehensive Plan, develop a 5-10 year concept level Waterfront Plan with implementation schedule, and to identify updates to the Dillingham Municipal code to reflect comprehensive waterfront plan policies; and

WHEREAS, there have been three (3) major public workshops on the whole plan, and more than thirty (30) separate meetings on different elements of the plan; and

WHEREAS, maps have been prepared for community land use planning; and

WHEREAS, the plan represents the input of a broad spectrum of community residents; and

WHEREAS, this plan provides guidance to elected, appointed, and acknowledged community leaders and all citizens; and

WHEREAS, the public review draft plan was made available for the public in written form and on the internet since May 15; and


WHEREAS, a public hearing on the plan was held November 16, 2010, and the Dillingham Planning Commission recommended approval of the 2010 Update of the Dillingham Comprehensive Plan at that meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Dillingham City Council met on February 22, 2011 in a Special Joint Meeting with the Planning Commission to review the draft Comprehensive Plan;


