RESOLUTION NO. 2011-39

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL APPROVING TASK ORDER NO. 1 WITH ALASKA MAP COMPANY AND AMENDING THE COMPANY'S CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham awarded a contract to the Alaska Map Company with Resolution 2010-39 on June 17, 2010, to update the City's addressing database and maps; and

WHEREAS, the contract for that project was awarded competitively based on a robust selection process involving two staff as well as a GIS professional who compared and interviewed seven responsive companies; and

WHEREAS, the execution of that project involved doing extensive historical research of the data; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Map Company is best prepared to cost-effectively continue the next stage of the GIS update, the creation of parcel ID numbers for linking data to the parcel database; and

WHEREAS, the parcel ID project will give the City an important land management tool; and

WHEREAS, this will benefit the departments of Public Works, Public Safety, Finance, Administration, and Planning;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The Dillingham City Council accepts the proposal from Alaska Map Company for a not-to-exceed amount of \$10,500.
2. The Dillingham City Council authorizes the City Manager to issue and sign Task Order No. 1 for the additional scope of work.
3. The Dillingham City Council authorizes extension of that contract until December 31, 2011.
