RESOLUTION NO. 2011-50

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH BRISTOL BAY AREA HEALTH CORPORATION TO ASSIST WITH A TEMPORARY PROGRAM TO PROVIDE SENIOR MEALS

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham Senior Center building was severely damaged by a break in the overhead water line on January 1, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the damages caused the building to be closed to the public for a period of several months for safety reasons; and

WHEREAS, the temporary closure of the Senior Center required the City to find an alternative location and facility that could temporarily provide the important meal program for the Senior Citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Dillingham School District Elementary School has very capably and graciously stepped to the fore and allowed the school kitchen and lunch room to include the Senior Citizen meal program in the school lunch program; and

WHEREAS, the School kitchen must close for the summer recess of the School year and can no longer support the Senior meals program after June 2011; and


WHEREAS, the Bristol Bay Area Health Corporation (BBAHC) has offered the use of the kitchen and cafeteria facilities at Kakanak Hospital in order to continue to provide meals to the Senior Citizens in the program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham and BBAHC have negotiated terms for a contractual agreement that would allow the Senior meals program to continue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dillingham City Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into a temporary contract not-to-exceed six months duration with BBAHC to provide a hot lunch program at \$6.60 per meal per participant until the Senior Center can resume its regular Senior Meals program.


