RESOLUTION NO. 2012-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO WAIVE THE ADVERTISING REQUIREMENTS TO CONTRACT WITH ARTICOM FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN E911 & RADIO CONSOLE SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the City's current E911 system has failed; and

WHEREAS, Dillingham Municipal Code (DMC) 4.30.120, allows waiving of purchase restrictions if the City Council determines that the public interest would best be served by waiving the procurement procedures in the form of a resolution adopted prior to the proposed action; and

WHEREAS, the waiver is based on the criteria outlined in DMC 4.30.130, Exemptions, B. 1, An emergency exists where the delays required for compliance with this section would jeopardize the public health, safety or welfare; B. 4, the services are of a professional nature requiring specialized knowledge and judgment; and


WHEREAS, the only other provider in the State of Alaska was non-responsive;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the City Manager to waive the advertising requirements and proceed to issue a Purchase Order to Arcticom for \$284,145.00 for the purchase and installation of an E911 plus Radio Console System.



