A RESOLUTION OF THE DILLINGHAM CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING A REDISTRICTING PLAN THAT WILL KEEP HOUSE DISTRICT 37 AND SENATE DISTRICT S INTACT

WHEREAS, the City of Dillingham is currently in House District 37 and Senate District S of the Alaska legislative districts; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska is in the process of redistricting as the result of the 2010 census report; and

WHEREAS, the current House and Senate districts represent an area that is culturally and economically tied; and

WHEREAS, the Bristol Bay Borough, the Alaska Peninsula and the Aleutian Chain have similar coastal economies, mainly based on seafood processing and harvesting; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure needs and community priorities of our communities are similar; and


WHEREAS, regional organizations such as the Bristol Bay Native Association, the Bristol Bay Economic Development Corporation, and the Southwest Alaska Municipal Conference reflect the common socioeconomic values and needs of this area;


